COMPACTOR OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Open door to dispose of items
- <u>DO NOT</u> Fill to the door opening!!
 - Place a Few Items in container at one time & Close Door so compactor can compress materials – Repeat
 - Break Down LARGE boxes so as NOT to JAM the compactor
- **<u>DO NOT OPEN DOOR</u> While Compactor is Operating!
 - This may cause the unit to malfunction or jam – WAIT for it to STOP before opening door
- If unit is JAMMED when you arrive, Please <u>Do Not</u> add more items to the container until maintenance can clear the jam.
