**ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS
OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE**

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Charter Township of Raisin located in Lenawee County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended (the "Act").

ORDAINS:

**SECTION I
AGENCY DESIGNATED**

Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of the Act, the Building Inspector of the Charter Township of Raisin ("Building Inspector") is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Charter Township of Raisin under the Act, State of Michigan. The Building Inspector assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the Township.

**SECTION II
CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED**

Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of the Act, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the Township.

**SECTION III
DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS**

Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") Flood Insurance Study ("FIS") entitled Flood Insurance Study Lenawee County, All Jurisdictions, dated August 15, 2019 and the Flood Insurance Rate Maps ("FIRMS") panel numbers of 26091IND0A, 26091C0192D, 26091C0194D, 26091C0202D, 26091C0205D, 260910206D, 2691C0210D and 26091C0225D, dated August 15, 2019 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the

Michigan Building Code, and to provide content of the “Flood Hazards” section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Building Code.

SECTION IV
REPEALS

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION V
PUBLICATION

This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
